### ASSESSMENTS ENTRY GUIDELINES

#### 1. WHO MAY ENTER

- Students from Active Etobicoke-Mississauga ORMTA members in good standing.

#### 2. WHEN THEY ARE HELD

- To be eligible for the Branch Competitions ONLY (Level Prep & up):
  - December
    - Instrumental entrants ONLY
  - February/March
    - Instrumental and Vocal entrants
  - November (**at Contemporary Showcase Mississauga**)
    - Instrumental and Vocal entrants
    - **Marks and adjudications for Contemporary Showcase entries will be allowed to stand for the ORMTA Branch Competitions.**
- To be eligible for the Branch Competitions and the GTA Zone/Provincial Competitions (Level 8 & up):
  - February/March
    - Instrumental and Vocal entrants

#### 3. WHERE THEY ARE HELD

- Christ First
  - 1700 Mazo Crescent, Mississauga, ON
    - Instrumental held in the Sanctuary
    - Vocal held in the Merigold Room

#### 4. NUMBER OF PIECES TO PERFORM

- Solo entrants (to qualify for the Branch Competitions ONLY)
  - Prep –Level 10
    - 1 or 2 pieces

- Each piece is marked separately. To be eligible to compete at the Branch Competitions, one piece must receive a mark of 84 or higher.
- A.R.C.T & up
  - 2 pieces
  - Each piece is marked separately. To be eligible to compete at the Branch Competitions, one piece must receive a mark of 84 or higher.
- Duet and Trio entrants (to qualify for the Branch Competitions ONLY)
  - Prep – Advanced
    - 1 piece
- Solo entrants (to qualify for the Branch Competitions and the GTA Zone/Provincial Competitions)
  - Zone Intermediate & up
    - Refer to GTA Zone/Provincial Competitions requirements:

## 5. TIME LIMIT FOR PIECE(S)

- Each teacher is responsible for timing the piece(s) and staying within the allotted time limit.
- If playing more than one piece, all pieces must total less than the maximum time as outlined below:
  - Solo entrants (to qualify for the Branch Competitions ONLY)
    - Prep – Level 2
      - Maximum 3 minutes
    - Level 3 – 6
      - Maximum 4 minutes
    - Level 7 – 9
      - Maximum 10 minutes
    - Level 10
      - Maximum 15 minutes
    - A.R.C.T. & up
      - Maximum 20 minutes
  - Duet and Trio entrants (to qualify for the Branch Competitions ONLY)
    - No time limit
  - Solo entrants (to qualify for the Branch Competitions and the GTA Zone/Provincial Competitions)
    - Zone Intermediate Vocal (Level 8 & 9)
      - Maximum 10 minutes

- Zone Intermediate Instrumental (Level 8 & 9)
  - Maximum 10 minutes
- Provincial Vocal (Level 9 & up)
  - Minimum 15 minutes
  - Maximum 20 minutes
- Provincial Instrumental (Level 10 & A.R.C.T.)
  - Minimum 15 minutes
  - Maximum 20 minutes
- Zone Artist – *odd numbered years ONLY* (A.R.C.T. & up)
  - Minimum 30 minutes
  - Maximum 45 minutes
- Young Artist – *even numbered years ONLY* (A.R.C.T. & up)
  - Minimum 30 minutes
  - Maximum 45 minutes

## 6. FEES

### TEACHERS

- A one-time fee
  - **When attending**
    - \$5.00
  - **When NOT attending**
    - \$20.00

    - In the message field, be sure to specify your name and the event that the payment is going towards, e.g., “John Smith – December Assessments”.
    - Interac e-Transfers from entrants are NOT acceptable.
