FUN AFTERNOON RECITAL ENTRY GUIDELINES

1. PURPOSE

- This recital is a fundraiser for the Etobicoke-Mississauga Branch.
- Money raised will go toward our Student Scholarship Fund.

2. WHO MAY ENTER

- Students from Active Etobicoke-Mississauga ORMTA members in good standing.

3. WHEN IT IS HELD

- January
- For the specific date and time, go to our Branch's website to view or download the Branch Events document or browse the Calendar:

4. WHERE IT IS HELD

- Christ First (Downstairs from the Sanctuary)
 - 1700 Mazo Crescent, Mississauga, ON

5. NUMBER OF PIECES TO PERFORM

- Students may enter:
 - one solo piece
 - one ensemble piece
 - Each student is limited to a maximum of one solo piece and one ensemble piece.

6. TIME LIMIT FOR PIECE(S)

- Each teacher is responsible for timing the piece(s) and staying within the allotted time limit.
 - Solo piece
 - Maximum 2 minutes
 - Ensemble piece
 - Maximum 2 minutes

7. FEES

TEACHERS

- A one-time fee
 - **When attending**
 - \$5.00
 - **When NOT attending**
 - \$20.00

ENTRANTS

- These fees include the admission of performers, accompanists & guests.
 - Up to a maximum of \$25 per family
 - Maximum of 3 children per family
 - **One Piece ONLY** (a solo or an ensemble piece)
(Maximum Time – 2 minutes)
 - \$15.00
 - **Two Pieces** (one solo and one ensemble piece ONLY)
(Maximum Time – 4 minutes)
(Solo piece: 2 minutes – Ensemble piece: 2 minutes)
 - \$20.00
- Entry fees are non-refundable.

8. HOW TO REGISTER

- Go to this webpage:

 - If you have more entrants than space allotted on the form, simply fill in as many forms as needed, putting the total of all fees on the final page.
 - Send completed digital pdf event application form(s) and payment to the Treasurer (see #9 & 10 for further details).
- Apply early, as registration is on a first come, first serve basis due to the recital being limited to 100 minutes.

10. HOW TO SUBMIT APPLICATION FORM(S) AND PAYMENT

- Fill out the digital pdf event application form(s) and email it to: treasurer.etobmiss.ormta@gmail.com
 - If paying by Interac e-Transfer, immediately after emailing the application form(s), follow it up with ONE Interac e-Transfer, submitted by the teacher to the same email: treasurer.etobmiss.ormta@gmail.com

- In the message field, be sure to specify your name and the event that the payment is going towards, e.g., “John Smith – Fun Afternoon Recital”.
- Interac e-Transfers from entrants are NOT acceptable.

OR

- If paying by cheque, mail ONE cheque, submitted by the teacher, plus a printed copy of the application form(s) to:

- In the subject line, be sure to specify the event that the payment is going towards, e.g., “John Smith – Fun Afternoon Recital”.

- Cheques from entrants are NOT acceptable.

- Apply early, as registration is on a first come, first serve basis due to the recital being limited to 100 minutes.
- Event application forms will not be accepted after the deadline.

FUN AFTERNOON RECITAL RULES

1. Memorization is not necessary.
2. Students are encouraged to perform repertoire that is:
 - non-Classical
 - Fun
 - Modern
 - Contemporary Canadian
 - Pop/Rock/Jazz
 - Musical theatre
3. Photocopied music is NOT permitted.
4. Students must provide their own accompanist (if applicable).
5. Students and accompanists must arrive 15 minutes prior to show time.

6. On the event application form, teachers must indicate whether any specific equipment is required for their students' performance (e.g. CD player, music stands, etc.)

- Equipment requests made the day of the recital cannot be accommodated.

7. Recording guidelines:

- Permitted:
 - Parents recording the performance of their child for their own personal use.
- Prohibited:
 - Recording entrants other than one's own child.

8. Each family is to bring:

- some finger food (ex. chips, veggies, sweets, etc.)
 - Food must be PEANUT FREE and READY TO SERVE on a plate or in a bowl.
 - If the food has dipping sauce, please be sure to bring along required utensils for your tray.
 - Make note of your own bowls, plates and utensils to bring home.
- One unwrapped gift to donate towards the raffle.
 - New prizes ONLY (as opposed to used)
 - with proper working components

9. Each teacher, with students participating, is to bring:

- a bowl (or 2) of some finger food (ex. chips, pretzels, cheesies, etc.)
 - Food must be PEANUT FREE and READY TO SERVE in a bowl.
 - Make note of your own bowls to bring home.
- One unwrapped gift to donate towards the raffle.
 - New prizes ONLY (as opposed to used)
 - with proper working components

10. A group picture of all the performers will be taken at the end of the program.

11. Raffle details

- The raffle consists of various gifts.
- In order to participate in the raffle, tickets must be purchased.
- The raffle is CASH only
 - Teachers, please remind students to bring adequate money.
- Cost of raffle tickets:
 - 3 tickets
 - \$5
 - 12 tickets

- \$10

12. Donations to the Student Scholarship Fund are also welcome.

- Parents or teachers, who make a donation of \$20 or more, will be given an official tax receipt email.
- Cash or cheque is accepted the day of, from both teachers and parents.
 - Make cheque payable to “ORMTA Etobicoke-Mississauga Branch”.
 - Note at the bottom of the cheque: “Student Scholarship Fund”.
- Teachers may donate via Interac e-transfer at any time before or after the recital.
- Please make sure to write down detailed information on the sheet provided at the Raffle Tickets table.
